

OBJECTIVE To establish an Advisory Group that reviews the master plan, economic viability, rules and regulations, and safety measures of the Orlando Executive Airport.

METHOD OF OPERATION

Composition Pursuant to the Bylaws of the Aviation Authority, Commission members are appointed by the Aviation Authority Chairman subject to confirmation by the Aviation Authority Board. The Aviation Authority Chairman designates the Chairman of the Commission. The Commission members elect a Vice Chairman.

The Advisory Commission members are appointed for three-year terms, with the exception of the Aviation Authority staff members and the Aviation Authority Board representative. If a Board member is appointed onto the Commission, they will serve a two-year term, from May in even-numbered years, to May of the next even-numbered year.

The Commission is composed of the following voting members:

- Greater Orlando Aviation Authority Board Member,
- Two (2) OEA Fixed Base Operator Representatives,
- A Tenant Representative,
- Three (3) Citizens at Large.

The three citizens at large, whenever practical, are users of the Airport (tenants/FBO representatives are not prohibited from appointment as citizens at large).

If a permanent vacancy occurs in a voting member position the replacement member shall serve only the unexpired portion of the former members' term.

Function To provide the Aviation Authority with ideas, support and assistance in correcting deficiencies, and in resolving operational problems and conflicts.

Notice In compliance with the Florida Statutes governing public meetings, proper notice of Commission meetings will be given and minutes will be published.

Meetings Meetings are scheduled as necessary by the Chairman at a time and place designated by the Chairman.
