

Upcoming Construction Projects (Posted January 2022)

Orlando International Airport Construction Department 11312 Terminal C Service Road Orlando, FL 32824

The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) has an ongoing construction program and will be advertising for bids on various construction projects. This program includes both building construction and civil work at Orlando International Airport and Orlando Executive Airport. The construction values of the individual projects are estimated to be between \$300,000 and \$100 million.

For federally funded construction projects, GOAA has adopted a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) policy. For non-federally funded construction projects, GOAA has adopted a Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Policy, a Local Developing Business Enterprises (LDB) Policy, and a Veteran Business Enterprise (VBE) Policy. These participation goals will be established by GOAA on a project-by-project basis.

The below listed projects are scheduled to be advertised and/or bid during the next three months.

SOUTH TERMINAL C PROGRAM

The Aviation Authority has embarked on a multi-year Capital Improvement Program for the construction of the South Terminal Complex at the Orlando International Airport. Construction of the South Terminal C Landside and Airside Terminal Facilities is underway with an anticipated completion date of 2022.

The Aviation Authority is utilizing the Construction Management at Risk (CM@R) procurement method for the construction of the South Terminal C Program. The two CM@R entities currently being utilized by the Aviation Authority are Hensel Phelps Construction, and Turner-Kiewit Joint Venture. NORTH TERMINAL COMPLEX

BP-00496-MCO EAST AIRFIELD TAXIWAYS REHABILITATION - PHASE 2 (TAXIWAYS J, L, N and N1-N6)

CONSTRUCTION VALUE: Between \$15M and \$20M ADVERTISE: February 2022 BIDS DUE: March 2022

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Rehabilitation of Taxiways J, L, N and Taxiway Connectors N1 through N6, located in the East Airfield between Runway 17L-35R and Runway 17R-35L at the Orlando International Airport. The construction work includes improvements to the taxiway pavement geometry and taxiway safety areas for compliance with the FAA current standards, mill and overlay for the existing asphalt pavement, resealing joints and replacing cracked slabs for the concrete pavement, applying surface treatment to the existing taxiway asphalt shoulders, and related improvements for the taxiway markings, lighting and signage.

MAJOR TRADES: Airfield Construction; Airport Lighting and Equipment; Asphalt Pavement; Painting and Striping; and Signage.
