The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) has an ongoing construction program and will be advertising for bids on various construction projects. This program includes both building construction and civil work at Orlando International Airport and Orlando Executive Airport.

For federally funded construction projects, GOAA has adopted the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) policy. For non-federally funded construction projects, GOAA has adopted the Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Policy, the Local Developing Business Enterprises (LDB) Policy, and the Veteran Business Enterprise (VBE) Policy. Participation goals will be established by GOAA on a project-by-project basis.

The below listed projects are scheduled to be advertised and/or bid during the next three months.

## ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (MCO)

### TERMINAL C COMPLEX

The Aviation Authority has embarked on a multi-year Capital Improvement Program for the construction of the Terminal C Complex at the Orlando International Airport. Construction of the Terminal C Landside and Airside Terminal Facilities is underway with a Phase 1/Phase 1 Expansion completion date of 2025.

### BP-S00198-MCO Terminal C Multi-Modal Connector Pedestrian Bridge and Rental Car Lobby (Design/Build)

CONSTRUCTION VALUE: Between \$80M and \$100M  
ADVERTISE: November 2022 BIDS DUE: April 2023

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Design and construction services required to complete the construction of approximately 450 ft. of an elevated, enclosed and conditioned pedestrian walkway and adjacent rental car lobby area on the north side of the pedestrian walkway that will directly connect the new Terminal C with the existing multi-modal facility that will serve up to four forms of passenger rail and all forms of public and private ground transportation. The Project must comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act, provide accessibility for all individuals, and include four moving walkways, and elevators, escalators and stairs. The Project includes rental car counters and queuing areas, multi-use information displays, interior landscaping, and preservation of all future capabilities for baggage right-of-ways and connection to future facilities and parking facilities.

MAJOR TRADES: Asphalt Placement; Concrete Placement and Finishing; Demolition; Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning (HVAC); Drywall/Acoustical; Earthwork and Grading; Electrical/Low Voltage; Electrical Lighting and Fixtures; Elevators/Escalators; Fire Protection/Security Systems; Floor Covering - Installation and Removal; Glass and Glazing - HVAC/Mechanical; Masonry; Mechanical; Metal Fabrication/Framing; Millwork/Finishes/Fixtures; Paint and Wall Covering; Painting and Striping; Plumbing; Retaining Walls; Roadway Construction; and, Roofing/Waterproofing.

### **TERMINALS A AND B COMPLEX**

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## **ORLANDO EXECUTIVE AIRPORT (ORL)**

### **BP-00049-ORL, ORL TAXIWAYS A, B AND E4 REHABILITATION**

CONSTRUCTION VALUE: Between \$1M and \$3M  
ADVERTISE: February 2023 BIDS DUE: March 2023

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Rehabilitate Taxiways A, B and B1; demolish portions of Taxiways E4 and E5; and construct new Taxiway E4 between Runway 13-31 and its parallel Taxiway E, at the Orlando Executive Airport. The construction work will include new asphalt pavement, mill and overlay existing asphalt pavement, and new and associated improvements for taxiway markings, lighting and signage.

MAJOR TRADES: Airfield Construction; Airport Lighting and Equipment; Asphalt Pavement; Demolition; Earthwork and Grading; and Painting and Striping.
