WHEREAS, by Agreement dated December 22, 2015, Authority and Consultant entered into an agreement for Consultant to provide **Program and Project Management Services for the South Terminal C, Phase 1** at Orlando International Airport; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, Consultant agreed to perform such additional services for the Authority as are contained in any additional scope of work established by the Authority in any addendum to the Agreement and accepted in writing by the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Amendment to the Agreement to provide for additional services to be rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A." Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.
- 2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the LUMP SUM amount of FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY-SIX AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$475,196.00), broken down as follows:

Management Services (OAR), Orlando International Airport

On September 15, 2021, the Aviation Authority Board approved Addendum 21 in the amount of \$1,843,816.00. On May 18, 2022, the Aviation Authority Board approved Amendment 1 to the Addendum in the amount of \$334,580.00. Since that time, it has been determined that additional program and project management services are required for W-S111, South Terminal C (Phase 1) through completion of the South Terminal C (Phase1) project. These additional services include providing assistance to the GOAA staff in the areas of technology consulting & support.

Additional support services are required as detailed in the consultant's proposal, dated June 02, 2022. Services are effective through the completion of the South Terminal C (Phase 1).

If approved, these services would be effective the date of August 01, 2022. These additional OAR services are subject to Aviation Authority Board approval of the June CIP update and subsequent CFOC action to add funding to the W-S00111 project.

Consultant shall, with each monthly invoice, certify that the assigned work and services are on schedule to be completed within the contracted lump sum price, or provide at time of certification, a written notice to the Authority of any deviations.

The DBE participation has been reviewed by the Office of Small Business Development. Their findings and recommendation are attached.



ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation of the Construction Committee to Approve an Amendment to Addendum No. 21 to the Program and Project Management Services Agreement for South Terminal C, Phase 1, Program, with Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI for Additional Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Construction Phase Owners Authorized Representative (OAR) Technology Consulting and Support Services for W-S00111, South Terminal C, Phase 1 – Program and Project Management Services, at the Orlando International Airport

BACKGROUND

In 2015, the firms providing Program and Project Management Services for South Terminal C Program were selected through a competitive award process. These services are paid for on an annual basis through program duration.

On October 21, 2015, the Aviation Authority Board approved a Program and Project Management Services Agreement for the South Terminal C, Phase 1, at the Orlando International Airport, with the following firms:

- Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI (MWBE)
- CMTS Construction Management Services, LLC (MWBE)
- Geotech Consultants International, Inc. dba GCI, Inc. (DBE/MWBE)
- Kraus-Manning, Inc. (LDB)
- NV5, Inc.

These Services may include, but are not limited to, any and all services necessary for the management of the various Aviation Authority contracts for the Project, the management of design from planning and conceptual design phase through detailed design, bidding and award of construction contracts; extension of staff services, development of design criteria documents, specifications review and coordination, Building Information Modeling (BIM) development and implementation and management of construction contracts, including design/build and construction management at risk; management of the construction and commissioning of projects including performing as the OAR; development and implementation of project cost controls and documents; providing material testing, quantity surveying, construction inspection, construction safety compliance inspection, and other services required to verify compliance of construction with contract documents; providing cost estimating, cost control, scheduling, progress reporting, and planning services to support both design and construction activities; negotiating contracts for project related professional and construction services required from the Aviation Authority's other consultants and contractors; coordination with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), and other governmental agencies on project-related issues; coordination of the activities of multiple consultants and contractors onsite; and all other related services, which may be required to accomplish

the planning, funding, design, bidding and award, construction, commissioning and operation of the Project, which includes both existing and future facilities.

On September 15, 2021, the Aviation Authority Board approved Addendum No. 21 to the Program and Project Management Services Agreement for South Terminal C, Phase 1, Program, with Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI for FY 2022 Construction Phase OAR Technology Consulting and Support Services for W-S00111, South Terminal C, Phase 1 – Program and Project Management Services, at the Orlando International Airport, for the total amount of \$1,843,816. Since then, on May 18, 2022, Amendment No. 1 to Addendum No. 21 has been approved for \$334,580.

ISSUES

On June 15, 2022, the Aviation Authority Board approved a net increase of \$40 million to the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for the Orlando International Airport, which is directly related to the budget and funding plan for the South Terminal C Program. The fees for today's New Business Agenda Item C are part of this \$40 million.

A fee has been negotiated with Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI for the total amount of \$475,196 for Additional FY 2022 Construction Phase OAR Technology Consulting and Support Services for W-S00111, South Terminal C, Phase 1, at the Orlando International Airport. These additional services include technology and Building Information Modeling (BIM) support, Owner-Furnished Materials (OFM) documentation and process support, management of designers of technology, Information Technology (IT) and signage systems, coordination of schedules and purchase of IT procurement items, special systems coordination with other project disciplines, and close-out efforts.

Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI is a certified Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) firm. The Aviation Authority has reviewed the proposal and determined that Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI does not propose any Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation on this amendment due to the specialized technology support services required for this assignment.

Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI anticipates utilizing the following subconsultants for these services:

• Hahn Integrated Systems, Inc.

On June 7, 2022, the Construction Committee recommended approval of an Amendment to Addendum No. 21 to the Program and Project Management Services Agreement for South Terminal C, Phase 1, Program, with Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI for Additional FY 2022 Construction Phase OAR Technology Consulting and Support Services for W-S00111, South Terminal C, Phase 1 – Program and Project Management Services, at the Orlando International Airport, as outlined in the memorandum.

Fiscal impact is \$475,196. Funding is from General Airport Revenue Bonds.

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board resolve to accept the recommendation of the Construction Committee and approve an Amendment to Addendum No. 21 to the Program and Project Management Services Agreement for South Terminal C, Phase 1, Program, with Cost Management, Inc. dba CMI for Additional FY 2022 Construction Phase OAR Technology Consulting and Support Services for W-S00111, South Terminal C, Phase 1 – Program and Project Management Services, at the Orlando International Airport, for a total lump sum fee amount of \$475,196, with funding from General Airport Revenue Bonds; and, authorize an Aviation Authority Officer or the Chief Executive Officer to execute the necessary documents following satisfactory review by legal counsel.
