Chairman Friel announced to all present that if a bidder or proposer is aggrieved by any of the proceedings of today's meeting and wishes to appeal the results of actions made by this Committee, they must file an appeal stating the item they wish to appeal and the basis for which they wish to appeal, and it must be received in writing by the Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Phillip N. Brown, via email pbrown@goaa.org with copy to larissa.bou@goaa.org, by Monday, February 1, 2021, at 4:00 p.m. (emails will be accepted during the pandemic COVID-19).

For individuals who conduct lobbying activities with Aviation Authority employees or Board members, registration with the Aviation Authority is required each year prior to conducting any lobbying activities. A statement of expenditures incurred in connection with those lobbying instances should also be filed prior to April 1 of each year for the preceding year. Before proceeding to business, Chairman Friel, asked Committee members to report any conflicts of interest or violations of the Aviation Authority's Code of Ethics and Business Conduct; lobbying activities policy; or the Florida Sunshine law with regard to any agenda item. None were expressed by any Committee member.

MINUTES

1. Upon motion by Mr. Draper, second by Mr. Engle, motion passed to accept the December 14, 2020 and January 11, 2021, minutes as written.

RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT NO. 16 FOR TWO (2) RENEWAL OPTIONS AND A CONTRACT ADJUSTMENT FOR PURCHASING CONTRACT 02-11, COMMON USE PASSENGER PROCESSING SYSTEM (CUPPS) AND COMMON USE SELF SERVICE (CUSS) OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES, WITH SITA INFORMATION NETWORKING COMPUTING USA, INC. (SITA)

2. Ms. Hershner presented the item.

The initial project under this contract commenced on November 1, 2011, with final acceptance effective May 21, 2012. The initial term of the contract was for thirty-six (36) months, effective May 22, 2012, expiring May 21, 2015, with the Aviation Authority having an indefinite number of options to renew the contract for additional periods of one (1) year each. The sixth renewal option will expire on May 21, 2021.

The contract requires SITA to furnish to the Aviation Authority detailed technical design, development, hardware, firmware, software, software licenses, installation integration, implementation, training, user manuals and documentation, operation, support and maintenance services for the CUPPS and CUSS, warranty, testing of the hardware and software, and all other items necessary or proper for, or incidental to, providing an operable and acceptable CUPPS and CUSS, including associated gateways for each airline that is dependent on a remote host computer for departure control, and a Local Departure Control System for each airline that operates independent of a remote host computer and other related components, all in accordance with the contract documents.

This Amendment will: (1) exercise the seventh and eighth renewal options through May 22, 2023; and (2) add a statement of work for Microsoft Windows upgrades.

Seventh Renewal Option - May 22, 2021 - May 21, 2022, for an approximate annual value of \$1,608,420.

Eighth Renewal Option - May 22, 2022 - May 21, 2023, for an approximate annual value of \$1,872,290.

Contract Adjustment - Staff is requesting to upgrade Microsoft Windows Operating Systems, for an approximate value of \$371,425.

Department - Concurs with the seventh and eighth renewal options, and with the contract adjustment.

Contractor - Based on the information known at this time, the contractor has performed satisfactorily during the last renewal option.

This is a service contract for the support and maintenance of the CUPPS and CUSS. The renewal option pricing is based on existing hourly labor rates for support. SITA has agreed to maintain the current prices without their standard CPI increase.

This contract did not include a Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) or Local Developing Business (LDB) participation requirement.

The total fiscal impact for the seventh renewal option is a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,608,420. Funding for the seventh renewal option will be from the Operations and Maintenance Funds 301.521.214.5340007.000.100425, 301.521.214.5340007.000.100483, and 301.521.214.5520001.000.100483, and Capital Expenditure Funds 308.521.214.5640003.000. 501105 and 308.521.214.5640003.000.501440.

The total fiscal impact for the eighth renewal option is a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,872,290. Funding for the eighth renewal option will be from the Operations and Maintenance Funds 301.521.214.5340007.000.100425, 301.521.214.5340007.000.100483, and 301.521.214.5520001.000.100483, and Capital Expenditure Fund 308.521.214.5640003.000. 501440.

Funding for the contract adjustment is a not-to-exceed amount of \$371,425 will be from the General Airport Revenue Bond ZC-319.

Funds expected to be spent under the contract in the current fiscal year are within budget. Funding required in current and subsequent fiscal year will be allocated from the Operations and Maintenance Fund and Project Funds as approved through the budget process and when funds become available.

It was respectfully requested that the Concessions/Procurement Committee approve that the following be recommended to the Aviation Authority Board: (1) approve Amendment No. 16 for Two (2) Renewal Options and a Contract Adjustment for Purchasing Contract 02-11, Common Use Passenger Processing System and Common Use Self Service Operations and Maintenance Services, with SITA Information Networking Computing USA, Inc.; (2) authorize funding in the not-to-exceed amount of \$3,852,136 from the Operations and Maintenance Fund, and previously-approved Capital Expenditure Fund, and General Airport Revenue Bond; (3) authorize an Aviation Authority Officer or the Chief Executive Officer to execute the necessary documents following satisfactory review by legal counsel; and (4) authorize the Purchasing Department to issue the necessary Purchase Orders.

Chairman Friel asked if anyone in the audience would like to speak regarding this item. Ms. Bou confirmed she had not received any speaker requests. He then asked if any Committee member had questions or comments. Vice Chair Sharman asked if the Microsoft Windows upgrade includes SITA's labor and materials. Additionally, she asked the department to explain the reason for the contract adjustment. Mr. Pelletier explained that this includes both labor and materials for the Microsoft Windows upgrade, which is a core system needed to support the upgrade of the latest Windows to run properly. Vice Chair Sharman followed up by asking if this is done by SITA because it is their equipment. Mr. Persaud responded that the CUSS unit is a proprietary SITA product and the hardware within the system needs to be upgraded.

Vice Chair Sharman continued by asking for the reason of two renewals being requested at this time. Mr. Pelletier explained that the first renewal will end in the middle of when the South Terminal will be opening. Therefore, having the two renewals approved now, will allow for the continuation of service.

Vice Chair Sharman congratulated Mr. Persaud for his hard work and accomplishment in negotiating the rates to remain the same. Then, Vice Chair Sharman continued by referring to Attachment A (copy on file), under Amendment No. 15, which states that the 6th renewal option and contract adjustment value was \$1,599,920, and asked if there were any other elements included in that amount. Ms. Hershner indicated that the term "contract adjustment" is a scrivener's error, because there were no increase in hours or change in the scope of work for that amendment. Ms. Hershner indicated that the information will be reviewed and corrected.

Mr. Engle asked if the upgrade to Windows 7 is independent from the airlines specific operating systems. Mr. Persaud replied in the affirmative.

Upon motion by Mr. Draper, second by Ms. Silvers, vote carried to approve staff's recommendation.

This contract requires Helping Hand to furnish all labor, supervision, materials (including any replacement plant material required), supplies, tools, equipment, licenses, permits, chemicals, fertilizer, mulch, and all other items necessary or proper for, or incidental to, performing exterior landscape maintenance and irrigation services located along Tradeport Drive and surrounding areas at the Orlando International Airport (OIA) in accordance with the contract documents.

ISSUES

First Renewal Option - July 25, 2021 through July 24, 2022.

Department - Concurs with the renewal option.

Contractor - Based on the information known at this time, Helping Hand has performed satisfactorily during the initial term.

The annual value for the first renewal option is for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$355,020 with no rate increase. The actual amount paid to the contractor is based on actual work requested, performed, and approved by the Aviation Authority, based on the unit prices.

This contract has been designated as a directed procurement for a Local Developing Business (LDB). The Small Business Development department certifies that this contract is in good standing as it relates to LDB participation.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact for the first renewal option is a not-to-exceed amount of \$355,020 with funding from the Operations and Maintenance Fund 301.631.330.5340004.000.100008. Funds expected to be spent under the contract in the current fiscal year are within budget. The term of each renewal may range from a pro-rated period of less than 12 months to a not-to-exceed period of 60 months as appropriate for the renewal agreement purchased.

ISSUES

All Aviation Authority owned computer hardware and software licenses require support and/or maintenance to ensure the continuous operation of such computer hardware and/or software applications to support the operations of the Aviation Authority. The Aviation Authority's Information Technology (IT) Department provides routine user support needs, but almost all of the hardware and software applications are either proprietary, protected by a copyright, and/or protected under license agreement terms, and therefore require technical expertise that staff does not have. The Aviation Authority's Purchasing Department makes every effort to obtain competitive pricing on initial agreement purchases and agreement renewals, but in many cases, the agreements and the technical expertise required are only available directly from the original hardware or software manufacturers. The acquisition of maintenance agreements or support services in many cases from a supplier other than the manufacturer could void hardware warranties, result in equipment downtime, or violate copyright laws.

The Aviation Authority also has SaaS licensing agreements in which the software is not owned by the Aviation Authority but for which the Aviation Authority has purchased access. These agreements are required to support the operational needs of various Aviation Authority departments. The use of SaaS licensing agreements eliminates the Aviation Authority's need to purchase computer hardware and/or "traditional" software licenses. Computer hardware maintenance is the responsibility of the SaaS provider and software upgrades are included in the annual renewal costs.

The Aviation Authority also has Internet Based Subscription Service agreements in which the provider grants the Aviation Authority access to a proprietary database. These subscription services are required to support the operational needs of various Aviation Authority departments. The use of a Subscription Service agreement eliminates the Aviation Authority's need to contract for services to develop these databases and then subsequently continue to contract for services to continually update the database. The database is created by and continually updated by the service provider. These activities are included in the annual renewal cost.

The Small Business Development Department has reviewed the requirements for the above-referenced solicitation and determined that, due to the limited and specialized scope of the required services, and/or lack of ready, willing and able certified small businesses, it does not lend itself to MWBE/LDB/VBE participation.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated value of this request is \$8,719,331.39, which includes a contingency of 20%, through March 31, 2022. The value of renewal purchases made have been funded by the associated departments from the Operations and Maintenance Fund that is approved during the budget process. Funds expected to be spent in the current fiscal year are within budget. The departments requiring Technology Renewal purchases going forward intend to submit budget requests for funds expected to be spent under the resulting Purchase Orders in FY '22 and such requests, when considered with known or anticipated obligations of the departments for FY '22, do not exceed expected or reasonable funding approvals.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is respectfully requested that the Concessions/Procurement Committee approve that the following be recommended to the Aviation Authority Board: (1) approve the Purchases of Renewals of Computer Hardware and Software Maintenance, Support, Maintenance and Support, and Licenses on the attached list, which renew within the 12-month approval period of April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022; (2) authorize funding from previously-approved departments' Operations and Maintenance Funds in the not-to-exceed amount of \$8,719,331.39, which includes a 20% contingency for anticipated price increases and the purchase of new licenses and hardware support; and (3) authorize the Purchasing Department to award purchase orders for each renewal utilizing competitive quotations, direct negotiations, single source procurements, sole source procurements, other entities' contract (piggy-backing), procurement card, or other methods in compliance with referenced Aviation Authority policies.

ATTACHMENT A

Award Criteria:

The various manufacturers and services providers publish/provide pricing for renewal agreements/services annually. Some of the renewal agreements/services are only available directly from the manufacturer. Some of the manufacturers make their renewal agreements/services available only through distributors called "value added re-sellers" (VAR's) and, when this is the case, Staff makes every effort to compete the Aviation Authority's annual renewal agreement/service requirement among the available VAR's. The Purchasing Department will determine the method of purchase required for each renewal agreement/service.

Clarifications Required During the Process:

The Purchasing Department, in conjunction with the associated departments, will verify if a renewal agreement/service will be purchased utilizing one of the following methods as authorized by the Aviation Authority's Policies and Procedures:

- 1. By Competitive Procurements (Policy 450.02), which requires that Requests for Quotations be issued when the value is expected to exceed \$15,000.00.
- 2. Through Non-Competitive Procurements (Policy 450.03), which permits the procurement of Goods, Services, and Professional Services with limited or no competition. This would include the following methods: a) Sole Source Procurement, when the goods or services are limited to one source, or when they must be obtained from a specific manufacturer's dealer; b) Single Source Procurement, when the goods or services are procured from one firm among others in a competitive marketplace which, for justifiable reasons, is found to be most advantageous for the purpose of fulfilling the given purchasing need; c) a "Piggy-Back" purchase from a Supplier having a requirements contract, annual agreement, contract with any other public entity (Other Entity Contract); or d) by Direct Negotiation when the dollar value of the purchase does not exceed \$15,000.00.
- 3. By Procurement Card (Policy 450.10), which permits the use of an Aviation Authority issued procurement card for small order purchasing, within established limitations.

At its March 18, 2020 meeting the Aviation Authority Board approved a total not-to-exceed amount of \$7,570,243.24 for FY'20 - FY'21 for the purchase of computer hardware and software maintenance and support annual Service Agreements for the 12 month period of April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021. The total FY'20 - FY'21 expenditures totaled \$7,266,109.49 for that12 month period.

The total request for FY'21 - FY'22 is for \$8,719,331.39, which is a 20% increase over the FY'20 - FY'21 expenditures. This contingency will allow the addition of Service Agreements for items purchased for various construction projects and other items that will be coming off the warranty and initial maintenance periods that were paid for at the time of purchase, and possible increases as needed throughout the 12 month period of April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022.
