



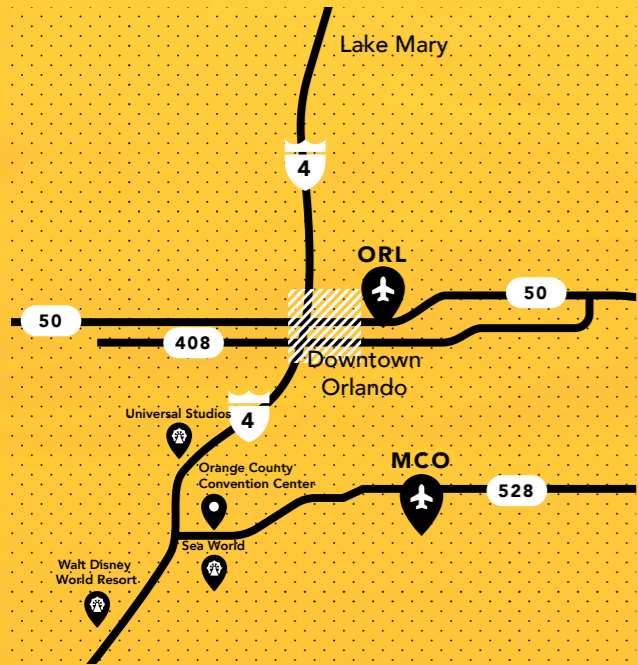
Located at the Center of it All

KITTINGER PARK

In 1992, Colonel Joe Kittinger Park opened in the southwest corner of Orlando Executive Airport. Named in honor of noted local aviator, Colonel Joe Kittinger Jr., USAF (Ret), the park features a F-4D Phantom dramatically displayed in honor of Vietnam War veterans of Central Florida, and live air traffic control broadcasts at its aviation-themed playground.

ORL HISTORY

- **1928**
Central Florida's first commercial airfield, Orlando Executive Airport was first dedicated as the Orlando Municipal Airport in 1928. Since that time, it has continually responded to the needs of a growing community.
- **1940 to 1946**
ORL operated as The Orlando Army Air Base training facility and home to Florida's first large-scale aircraft manufacturer.
- **1961**
ORL was renamed Herndon Airport after former Orlando City Engineer, A.B. Herndon, and operated passenger flights until 1968. Commercial service moved to Orlando Jetport at McCoy on McCoy AFB, known today as Orlando International Airport.
- **1976**
City of Orlando ceded control to the newly established Greater Orlando Aviation Authority.
- **1982**
Herndon Airport changed its name to Orlando Executive Airport.

Today, Orlando Executive Airport is recognized as the premier general aviation airport serving the entire Central Florida region – and among the best of its kind in the state and the nation.
