

Project Description and Responsibilities

A. Project Description (description of Agency's project to provide context, description of project components funded via this Agreement (if not the entire project)): Security Enhancements - The GOAA (Greater Orlando Aviation Authority) MCO (Orlando International Airport) Security Program provides updates and makes improvements to the existing Airport Security Program (ASP) and other security plans. Individual projects and GOAA funding are generally grouped into two major areas of work, CCTV and other Security Enhancements. Projects in the Security Enhancements and Close Circuit TV (CCTV) Programs are commissioned to resolve security weakness and/or further secure the public, personnel, airport real property and assets. Work will replace antiquated equipment technology upgrades and network improvements. They provide enhancements to physical and electronic security systems, including but not limited to re-keying, access control and monitoring systems and other equipment at various locations, portable guard booths, checkpoint modifications, building hardening, notifications systems, improvements to perimeter security fencing and monitoring, improvements to perimeter access points.

- B. Project Location (limits, city, county, map): Orlando International Airport/Orlando, FL/Orange
- C. Project Scope (allowable costs: describe project components, improvement type/service type, approximate timeline, project schedule, project size): Security Infrastructure project provides new Access Control System (ACS) at key doors, and intrusion detection on other key perimeter doors. The project also provides new CCTV coverage of select interior and exterior locations. To enable the two systems, the project will also provide equipment and associated infrastructure at various locations, network improvements to allow for IP addressable cameras, pathway, cabling, switch upgrades, and provision of Network Video Recording (NVR) appliances to enable these improvements. Addition of new cameras at various airport-wide locations, equipment and associate infrastructure will be provided. MCO expects to replace or provide approximately 850 cameras and supporting equipment within this multi-year project.

These projects, as required by 215.971 F.S., include as appropriate but not limited to consultant and design fees, permitting, surveys, material testing and construction testing costs, mobilization and demobilization, maintenance of traffic, demolition, supply and installation of equipment, support wiring and associated conduit/duct banks, dedicated primary and back-up power supplies, erosion control, excavation, embankment, ground preparation, fencing, posts, rails, gates sodding, seeding, provisions for electrical and fiber optic systems, signage, pavement and all materials, equipment, labor and incidentals required to complete the projects

D. Deliverable(s): Final closeout documents to be uploaded into Jacip.

The project scope identifies the ultimate project deliverables. Deliverables for requisition, payment and invoice purposes will be the incremental progress made toward completion of project scope elements. Supporting documentation will be quantifiable, measurable, and verifiable, to allow for a determination of the amount of incremental progress that has been made, and provide evidence that the payment requested is commensurate with the accomplished incremental progress and costs incurred by the Agency.

- E. Unallowable Costs (including but not limited to): Stored Materials.
- F. Transit Operating Grant Requirements (Transit Only):

Transit Operating Grants billed as an operational subsidy will require an expenditure detail report from the Agency that matches the invoice period. The expenditure detail, along with the progress report, will be the required deliverables for Transit Operating Grants. Operating grants may be issued for a term not to exceed three years from execution. The original grant agreement will include funding for year one. Funding for years two and three will be added by

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation to Accept a Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) Amendment for Orlando International Airport from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT)

BACKGROUND

Throughout the year, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) provides grants (i.e., PTGAs) to match funds with the Aviation Authority for certain projects in accordance with the Aviation Authority's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

ISSUES

The Aviation Authority has received the following PTGA Amendment for Orlando International Airport:

Amendment No. 1 to Public Transportation Grant Agreement FM 438486-2-94-01. This
 Amendment in the amount of \$1,000,000 provides an additional 50% funding for security program
 enhancements at the Orlando International Airport.

ALTERNATIVES

No alternatives are being considered at this time.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact is the acceptance of FDOT funding in the amount of \$1,000,000. This is a 50% grant with Aviation Authority's matching funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 from General Airport Revenue Bonds.

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board ratify the Resolution accepting PTGA FM 438486-2-94-01, and authorize the Acting Chief Executive Officer and the Assistant Secretary to execute the necessary documents.
