ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation of the Construction Committee to Approve an Addendum to the General Consulting Services Agreement with Ricondo & Associates, Inc. for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 On-Site Planning Support Services

BACKGROUND

In 2020, the firm providing General Consulting Services was selected through a competitive award process. On December 9, 2020, the Aviation Authority Board approved a General Consulting Services Agreement with Ricondo & Associates, Inc.

This no-cost base agreement established the negotiated hourly rates. These services are procured on an as-needed or annual basis, and include, but are not limited to, advising and supporting the Aviation Authority through assessments, studies, master planning, concept development, and preparation of design-build criteria packages, extension of staff, and other efforts as assigned for the development, management, and operation of the existing and future facilities. The services may also include interfacing with the Aviation Authority's committees and the Aviation Authority's departments, and coordinating and providing documentation required by federal, state, and local agencies, including the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA); the Transportation Security Administration (TSA); the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT); the Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC); the Division of Strategic Business Development; City of Orlando; Orange County, Florida; and, other agencies as required.

ISSUES

A fee has been negotiated Ricondo & Associates, Inc. for the total amount of \$399,896, for FY 2023 On-Site Planning Support Services. These general consulting services will include, but are not limited to, on-site staff support; land use and master planning support; strategic planning support; strategic marketing support for real estate and other revenue generating assets; development of standard operating procedures as identified by the Aviation Authority; development of wayfinding processes, guidelines and master plans; assistance with projects and programs; and other support tasks as required by the Aviation Authority. Services will be provided from October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023. At the discretion of the Aviation Authority, the level of provided services may be adjusted during the fiscal year, depending on fluctuations of Aviation Authority staffing levels.

The Aviation Authority has reviewed the proposal submitted by Ricondo & Associates, Inc. and determined that Ricondo & Associates, Inc. proposes 100% Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) participation on this addendum, and certifies that Ricondo & Associates, Inc. is in good standing as it relates to its small business participation.

On August 30, 2022, the Construction Committee recommended approval of an Addendum to the General Consulting Services Agreement with Ricondo & Associates, Inc. for FY 2023 On-Site Planning Support Services, as outlined in the memorandum.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact is \$399,896. Funding is from Operation and Maintenance Funds (subject to adoption of the FY 2023 Aviation Authority Budget by the Aviation Authority Board under separate item).

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board resolve to accept the recommendation of the Construction Committee and approve an Addendum to the General Consulting Services Agreement with Ricondo & Associates, Inc. for FY 2023 On-Site Planning Support Services, for a total not-to-exceed fee amount of \$399,896, with funding from Operation and Maintenance Funds; and authorize an Aviation Authority Officer or the Chief Executive Officer to execute the necessary documents following satisfactory review by legal counsel.
