Ricondo & Associates, Inc. (Ricondo) appreciates the opportunity to submit this proposal to assist the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) with the development of a vision for the future passenger terminal concessions experience at the Orlando International Airport (MCO). This proposal is for Phase 2 (Task 3) of this project. Phase 1, which includes Tasks 1 and 2, is currently underway. Phase 1 was approved on November 15, 2022 (Addendum #28 to the Agreement Dated January 8, 2021 between the GOAA and Ricondo).

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The visioning for the future passenger terminal concessions experience exercise will articulate the next generation of The Orlando Experience for the Terminals A, B, and C relative to GOAA's mission statement. The primary objectives for this MCO Visioning task include the following:

- Articulate values and guiding principles for developing the vision for the future passenger terminal concessions experience
- Explore imaginative and transformational ideas to promote and articulate the next generation of The Orlando Experience
- Develop holistic and unique visions and strategies in response to different "what-if" parameters
- Evaluate alternative visions and strategies in terms of key differentiators, priorities, benefits, constraints, and risks

The scope of work associated with Phase 3 is described in the sections that follow

Task 3 – Holistic Transformation Strategies

The efforts under Task 3 will include the following:

- Develop up to three unique holistic visions for future passenger terminal concessions experience.
- Evaluate alternative visions with respect to benefits and risks
- Identify future questions and next steps
- Develop a 3D rendering of the preferred vision plan



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Task 3.1 - Unique Alternative Holistic Visions Development

Ricondo would formulate up to three unique visions for the next generation of The Orlando Experience (denoting passenger flows, pre-security versus post-security zones, concessions or other amenities, etc.). Each unique vision would synthesize the ideas and themes from Task 2 into alternative holistic strategies and opportunities that respect guardrails prescribed by GOAA Leadership and respond to unique "what-if" parameters that would drive different visions for future passenger terminal and concessions experiences. Unique (differentiating) parameters would be developed in consultation with GOAA's project management team with the objective of injecting resilience into the decision-making process. Examples of unique parameters could include, priority setting, risk tolerance, technology adoption, or views of future changes to demographics and consumer preferences.

Task 3.2 - Key Differentiators - Benefits and Risks Evaluation

Ricondo would assist GOAA in establishing criteria to qualitatively and quantitatively evaluate intrinsic benefits and risks associated with the implementation of the alternative visions. Examples of criteria may include capital requirements, implementation timeline, and marketability.

Task 3.3 - Next Steps

Ricondo would assist GOAA in identifying questions and next steps that are common to all the alternatives and any questions and next steps that may be unique to one alternative.

Task 3 On-Site Workshops

Ricondo will conduct bi-weekly web meetings with GOAA's project management team to communicate approach, progress and needs. In addition, Ricondo will conduct the following on-site workshops as part of Task 3:

- Workshop 3.1 (WS 3.1) Alternative Vison Formulation Workshop
- GOAA Leadership Workshop
- Pre-Board Workshop
- Board Workshop
- GOAA Public Board Meeting

Task 3 Deliverables

The deliverables for this task will include:

- Workshop materials and meeting notes
- Long-term concepts including allocation of key interior passenger processing and interfacing functions (e.g., concessions) within landside terminals and airsides
- PowerPoint presentation summarizing key findings. This document will be provided in electronic format (Adobe PDF) only, no hard copies are included.



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- 3D rendering of the preferred vision plan
- Synthesis Report (PowerPoint): Ricondo will prepare a Synthesis Report in PowerPoint format that will summarize the findings of the previous tasks. The Synthesis Report will include graphics, photos, infographics, vision plans, etc. Ricondo will prepare and submit an electronic file version in Adobe PDF format of the draft Synthesis Report. Upon receipt of Airport staff comments, Ricondo will prepare a final draft for review and comment. Following the final review by Airport staff, Ricondo will prepare the final Synthesis Report. Ricondo will provide a total of 15 copies and an electronic file version in Adobe PDF format of the final Synthesis Report. No hard copies will be provided for the draft versions of the executive summary.

- On-site surveys
- Development of detailed cost estimates
- Passenger simulation modeling
- Budget for support from GOAA's commercial concessions consultant has not been included
- Aviation activity forecasts


Preliminary Schedule
