Please see the comments below for this item:

- 1. On the memo, I recommend the following edits:
 - a. revise project title to "E-S00015 Terminal C KVAR Pilot Program" to match iPro
 - b. correct the date to August 22, 2023
 - c. correct the funding statement to only General Airport Revenue Bonds
- 2. The memo states these are "Staff extension services"; however, both AECOM and BCSI's proposal letters indicate this item is for OAR Services. Which is correct?
- 3. On that note, is this item for design phase OAR services or construction phase OAR services? AECOM's proposal letter indicates construction phase, but BCSI has proposal letters for both the construction and design phase.
- 4. If this item includes construction phase OAR Services, will the job order or contractor award for the construction services also be going to the 8/22 CCM? Typically, construction phase OAR services cannot be awarded until the construction services are awarded.
- 5. AECOM is proposing a Sr. PM rate of \$238/hour; however, this the HOME rate for a Sr. PM working from AECOM's Tampa office and was approved under AECOM's continuing civil engineering agreement, not AECOM's OAR agreement. Based on the assumption that this item is for on-site, OAR/project oversight services, I recommend adjusting the Sr. PM rate to the GOAA approved FIELD rate of \$164/hour. Please review and revise the item as needed.
