(applicable to agreements that may be \$1,000,000 or more) Consultant hereby certifies that it is: (1) not on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135; and (2) not engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended.
- 4. Authority may terminate the Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel.

In the event the Agreement is for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, Authority may terminate this Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

5. Except as expressly modified in this Addendum, the Agreement dated April 24, 2018 and all prior addenda will remain in full force and effect.

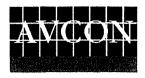

Further to our discussion with Tuan Nguyen and the enclosed, AVCON is pleased to submit our response for professional services to validate cross slope concerns at various locations at MCO from the recent FAR 139 Certification Inspection. AVCON will perform these services in conjunction with our subconsultant, BFA, Inc.

The following outlined services will be provided:

Airfield Operations and Access Coordination:

- AVCON will coordinate access to the project site to the extent possible using preplanned GOAA Maintenance windows of closure for the various runway and taxiway elements of the survey. Where needed, extended survey access may be required beyond these times to allow for survey setup and data collection;
- AVCON will accompany GOAA Operations representative to identify the project limits
 of the surveys prior to the actual field work commencing in order to limit the overall
 survey time in the field to the specific areas of concern raised by the FAA inspection.
 AVCON proposes to mark the limits of work on the edge of the shoulder pavement for
 easy identification during the actual surveys;
- 3. AVCON will accompany the surveyors in the field during the planned closure and survey data acquisition;

Topographic Survey:

- 1. Prepare a Topographic Survey of three areas as provided by AVCON, Inc. to identify the edge of pavement and validate cross slope/gradients within the runway safety areas. BFA shall locate the full-strength pavement edge, then the shoulder edge, and then another 150 feet on a 25-foot grid into the turf areas within the proposed limits of work. Elevations will be taken at a maximum of 25-foot intervals along with additional shots at existing features such as manholes, structures or above ground utility appurtenances.
- 2. Horizontal and Vertical Controls:
 - Vertical control data shall be based on the North American Vertical Datum 1988.
 Benchmark(s) shall be provided for each sheet of the Design Drawings.
 - b) The horizontal control data shall be relative to the Florida State Plane Coordinate system, East Zone, North American Datum of 1983/1990 adjustment.

- 2. The final drawing will be incorporated into standard GOAA titleblock sheets based on the most applicable GOAA project base mapping.

Compensation:
