ITEM DESCRIPTION

Request for Approval of an Amendment to Addendum No. 03 to the Design Services for Taxiways G & H Rehabilitation Phases 1 & 2 with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for Construction Administration Services for BP-497 Taxiways G and H Rehabilitation – Phase 1 at Orlando International Airport

BACKGROUND

On September 26, 2023, the Construction Committee approved Addendum No.03 in the amount of \$632,984.00 to the above-referenced agreement. The project's scope is to provide the Phase 1 Construction for the Rehabilitation of Taxiways G and H and their connectors, North of Taxiway E. Construction work includes resealing the joints and replacing isolated cracked slabs for the concrete pavement, rehabilitating the asphalt shoulders, and improvements for the taxiways' geometry, lighting, marking and signage.

ISSUES

Since then, it has been determined that design revision was required by FAA based on feedback from the Air Traffic Control Tower, as further described in the Consultant's proposal, dated May 15, 2024. AECOM Technical Services, Inc. is to provide additional Construction Administrative Services to help address the comments from FAA. The originally proposed project work for BP-497 generally consists of the following: Rehabilitate the aged pavement, markings, lighting, and signage; Modify the pavement geometry to meet current regulatory criteria; Drainage infrastructure improvement required by the updated pavement geometry; Eliminating the direct access from Airsides 2 and 4 to Runway 17R-35L. After the approval to award the contract, the FAA Air Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) expressed concerns about the scope of the project. Their specific worry was that the elimination of portions of TWY H1, TWY H2, and TWY H3 would limit the ability of the controllers to move aircraft efficiently during congested times or when conditions were unfavorable. These concerns were escalated both at GOAA and FAA culminating in a meeting held on December 7, 2023.

Based on the outcome of the meeting, GOAA has provided direction to AECOM to revise the BP-497 project design to reflect these changes. The changes were made under Bulletin No. 01 and are summarized as follows Geometric modifications at Taxiways H1, H2, and H3 have resulted in changes to the demolition plans, point elevation plans, plan and profiles, geometry plans, paving plans, typical sections and details, taxiway cross section plans, grading plans, drainage plans, drainage structure details, underdrain plans, drainage pipe desilting and CCTV inspection plans, marking plans and details, phasing and barricade plans, and safety and security notes and details. The electrical sheets have been modified to reflect these geometric changes. The changes to the electrical sheets include lighting layout, signage layout, sign panel messages, circuiting, junction can plaza, duct bank, and the ALCMS graphic. Also, for the change an increase in isolated slab replacements and additional light replacements are required. New light fixture types have been added to the legend sheet, technical specifications, pay items, and quantities. A modifier description has also been added to explain the scope of work for the Runway Status Lights affected.

An additional twenty (20) isolated slabs between the Taxiway H1 hold bar and Runway 17R-35L have been added for replacement. Drainage structure modifications have been added to this ESI #1 to reflect the changes from RFI's #2 and #3. Changes in quantities are reflected in the plan sheet revisions.

After some deliberation, FAA provided further direction that the portions of Taxiways H1, H2, and H3 in question should not be updated in the project to the current geometric standards. Based on this direction, GOAA directed AECOM to update the project design to reflect the change. The changes were provided to the Contractor in Bulletin No. 02 which made the following revisions: Geometric modifications have been made at Taxiways H1, H2, and H3 have resulted in plan sheet revisions to account for the changed scope of work to eliminate the geometric modifications at Taxiways H1, H2, and H3.

If approved, services will be effective the date of Construction Committee approval.

SMALL BUSINESS

The DBE participation has been reviewed by the Office of Small Business Development. Their findings and recommendation are attached.

ALTERNATIVES

None.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding is from the Federal Aviation Administration & Florida Department of Transportation grants to the extent eligible, GOAA Capital Expenditure, and Line of Credit to be reimbursed by future General Airport Revenue Bonds. Funding source verified by Malvin Warting of Construction Finance on $\frac{08}{\sqrt{05}}$ as correct and available.


