Based on discussion with GOAA staff and you, and the previous approval of the design task, AVCON is pleased to provide this supplemental proposal for SUE services and surveying from Echo UES, LLC.to support the preparation of plans and documentation package for the initial task for Overhead Signage Continuing Contract W-00447. The general scope of this task is to provide the design for an overhead truss sign structure, comprising two foundations and the overhead truss.

The following scope of work is proposed:

SUE Services - Verification of utility location and characteristics.

At locations selected by the Client, ECHO will attempt to expose utilities via minimally intrusive methods (e.g., use of vacuum excavation) to confirm their characteristics (e.g., type, size, material, direction, configuration) and provide an accurate location. At completion of each excavation (test hole) ECHO will record all verifiable utility information, mark the utility location with the most appropriate method (e.g., wooden lathes, "X" mark on concrete, disc and nail on asphalt) and restore the field to as close as possible to its original conditions. For this effort, ECHO will attempt to achieve the ASCE/Cl 38-02 Utility Quality Level A. ECHO proposes to perform up to 10 utility verification test holes in support of the design of two (2) signal foundations.

Survey of utility and topographic information

Following the utility locate services, Echo will provide the following topographic surveys for the two foundation sites:

- → Set/recover horizontal and vertical control throughout the project limits to collect the topographic and subsurface utility engineering information.
- → Collect aboveground and visible features and improvements within the highlighted limits as shown and described by the attached graphic, to include utility information as identified per the steps above.
- → Detail and survey gravity storm and sanitary systems located within the project limits.
- → Collect sufficient elevation data to create a digital terrain model (DTM) of the site.

- > Survey geotechnical borings and wetland flags as placed by others, if any.
- → Survey individual trees with DBH > 6", if any.
- The survey will be based on the North American Datum of 1983 (NAD83), East Zone and elevations will be referenced to the North American Vertical Datum 1988 (NAVD 88).
- The horizontal and vertical survey control will be provided in the final survey in tabular format for use by the contractor during construction activities.
- Recover and tie down sufficient monumentation in the field to calculate the existing apparent right-of-way along all public roadways within the project limits, and existing apparent property limits for parcels or portions thereof included within the project limits.
- → Right-of-way and property limits will be shown as calculated based on field monumentation and it will be referred to as apparent right-of-way and apparent property lines. Any additional field and office work to establish R/W limits and property boundaries shall be quoted separately and performed following receipt of title information to be provided by Client. (if applicable).

Based on this scope of work and the attached C-Tables fee breakdown, we have identified a total **Not-to-Exceed** fee of **Eleven thousand four hundred thirty and no/100 dollars (\$11,430.00)**. ECHO provides 90.6% MWBE participation for this supplement. There is a minor cost for the AVCON administration of this supplement.
