WHEREAS, the Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Amendment to the Agreement to provide for a final settlement for services rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall reduce services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A."
- 2. Authority shall be compensated for such reduction in services in the **CREDIT amount** of **TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE AND** 64/100 DOLLARS (\$288,821.64), broken down as follows:

In October 2015, the Aviation Authority awarded five contracts for Program and Project Management Services for the South Terminal C, Phase 1 (a/k/a Terminal C OAR contracts) to the following firms:

- Geotechnical Consultants International, Inc. (GCI)
- Cost Management, Inc. (CMI)
- Page One Consultants, Inc., n/k/a NV5
- KMI International Inc. (KMI) final payment made
- CMTS Construction Management Services, LLC (CMTS) final payment made

Background for this Addendum

The scope of Addendum 021 included construction phase technology consulting and support services. On September 15, 2021, the Aviation Authority Board approved Addendum 21 in the amount of \$1,843,816.00. On May 18, 2022, the Aviation Authority Board approved Amendment 1 to the Addendum in the amount of \$334,580.00. On July 20, 2022, the Aviation Authority Board approved Amendment 2 to Addendum 21 in the amount of \$475,196.00. On June 28, 2022, the Construction Committee approved Amendment 3 to Addendum 21 in the amount of \$0.00. On September 6, 2022, the Construction Committee approved Amendment 4 to Addendum 21 in the amount of \$110,779.36. On November 2, 2022, the Construction Committee approved Amendment 5 to the Addendum in the amount of \$273,600.00.

Issues

On September 20, 2022, Terminal C opened to passenger traffic. Final payment has been made on two of the Terminal C OAR contracts (KMI and CMTS) with no issues, as those contracts were more limited in scope and did not have any subconsultants.

For the remaining three Terminal C OAR contracts, a global final settlement has been negotiated to resolve all requests for cost, time, and any other issues that were or could have been raised in connection of the W-S111 OAR contracts and the performance of OAR project management services for Terminal C.

The proposed settlement includes the following amendments, which result in a net credit to the Aviation Authority:

Addendum 21 has been reconciled based on actual invoices and the remaining balance of \$288,821.64 is to be returned to the program budgets to be re-purposed for other program soft costs. The OAR firms and their subconsultants have agreed to submit a final invoice for each addendum of their W-S111 contracts no later than October 30, 2023. The OAR firms and their subconsultants have accepted final payment on all other addenda/amendments that are not included in the above table and have agreed that no additional invoices will be submitted.

The Aviation Authority acknowledges that the services have been satisfactory performed and it has received the benefit of the services, which were instrumental in the successful completion of the construction services and opening of Terminal C. Since that time, lessons learned and best practices regarding capital program management have been incorporated into the Authority's capital program. Specifically, an executive program management firm has been retained for the follow-on expansion of Terminal C projects to avoid having a patchwork of multiple project management contracts with multiple addenda and amendments spanning different time periods.

The 2022 continuing program and project management services contracts are <u>not</u> impacted by this settlement.

There is no impact on the MWBE or LDB participation goals. This settlement will facilitate the final payment to this certified MWBE firm.

Funding is from General Airport Revenue Bonds and FDOT. Funding source verified by *Melvin Martine* of Construction Finance on 09 / 28 / 23 as correct and available.

It is respectfully requested that the Construction Committee recommend to the Aviation Authority Board approve an Amendment to Addendum No. 21 to the Program and Project Management Services Agreement with Cost Management, Inc. to reduce the Addendum as shown below.
