DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE:

- 1. Add access control card reader and audible alarm to double doors entering the FIS. Provide material and labor to add a card reader and an audible alarm to the south side of Double-doors 06-0060 that enter the FIS for security. ADD: \$6,290.70
- 2. Lower ACS Card Reader at the CBP Gate. Provide material and labor to lower the existing access control pedestal at the CBP Gate. Also, tack weld grab bar bolts at the CBP Hold rooms. ADD: \$2,187.03
- 3. Add Miscellaneous CBP Signage. Provide material and labor to install miscellaneous CBP signage. ADD: \$6,408.55
- 4. Change Pylon Sign Faces to Global Entry. Provide material and labor to install two new pylon sign faces to change "Trusted Traveler" to "Global Entry". ADD: \$2,187.14
