# ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT DATED MAY 14, 2024 BETWEEN THE GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY AND THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC.

**THIS ADDENDUM** is effective this 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2024, by and between the **GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY** ("Aviation Authority"), and **THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC.** ("Consultant').

### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, by Agreement dated May 14, 2024, Aviation Authority and Consultant entered into an agreement for Consultant to provide Continuing Program and Project Management Services for Airfield, Roadway, and Horizontal Construction Projects consulting services; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Agreement, Consultant agreed to perform such additional services for the Aviation Authority as are contained in any additional scope of work established by the Aviation Authority in any addendum to the Agreement and accepted in writing by the Consultant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Addendum to the Agreement to provide for additional services to be rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A." Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.
- 2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the **NOT TO EXCEED amount of ONE HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$130,368.00)**, broken down as follows:

Not to Exceed Professional Fees: NTE: \$130,368.00
Lump Sum Professional Fees: LS: \$0.00
Not to Exceed Reimbursable Expenses: NTE: \$0.00

Total: \$130,368.00

 A. Consultant hereby certifies that it is not on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List and is not engaged in a boycott of Israel, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended;

### AND

- B. (applicable to agreements that may be \$1,000,000 or more) Consultant hereby certifies that it is: (1) not on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135; and (2) not engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended.
- Aviation Authority may terminate the Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel.

In the event the Agreement is for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, Aviation Authority may terminate this Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

Except as expressly modified in this Addendum, the Agreement dated May 14, 2024, and all prior addenda will remain in full force and effect.

### Background:

- Coordination with Aviation Authority departments, its Consultants, the City of Orlando, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), and any other agencies having jurisdiction over Aviation Authority facilities; and,
- All other related or similar services, which may be required or requested.

### **Small Business Participation:**

While the nature of the requested services (extension of staff/OAR support) does not currently allow small business participation, Corradino remains committed to incorporating meaningful small business participation in future assignments.

### Initial Period of Services:

This initial scope of services is expected to be for the period June 2024 through September 2024.
