### PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF 49 CFR PART 23

The ACDBE Goal and Program Applicability, include but are not limited to:

- Ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of opportunities for concessions;
- Create a level playing field on which ACDBEs can compete fairly for opportunities for concessions;
- Ensure that the ACDBE program is narrowly tailored;
- Ensure that only firms that fully meet this part's eligibility standards are permitted to participate as ACDBEs;
- Remove barriers to the participation of ACDBEs; and
- Provide appropriate flexibility to airports in establishing and providing opportunities for ACDBEs.



### **ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENT**

49 CFR § 23.41 (b)

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires that all airports receiving DOT financial assistance with non-car rental and car rental revenue, each in excess of \$200,000.00 averaged over the preceding three years, to submit a non-car rental and car rental overall ACDBE goals.

#### STEPS TO CALCULATE THE TRIENNIAL ACDBE GOALS

Large & Medium Hub Primary airports must update and submit their overall ACDBE goals every three years based on a schedule.

- Establish the overall goal through:
  - Race-Neutral/Race-Conscious Goals
- Airports must use a two-step process (methodology) to determine each goal:
  - 1. Calculation of the base figure for relative availability of ACDBEs.
  - 2. Adjustment of the base figure to arrive at overall goal

#### **MARKET AREA**

The market area is defined by the geographical area in which the substantial majority of firms that seek to do concession business with the airport are located and the geographical area in which the firms receive the substantial majority of concession-related revenues are located. Your market area may be different for different types of concessions (49 CFR Part 23.51 (b) (3)).

### RACE-NEUTRAL PARTICIPATION BREAKDOWN

- Step 2 adjustment of base figure with median past participation: 26%
- Median overachievement for the previous five fiscal years: 7%
- Using this figure as a race-neutral projection for the next three years, the Aviation Authority can establish that 7% of the goal can be met through race-neutral methods, while the remaining 19% must be attained using race-conscious means.

### **ACDBE PARTICIPATION**

The Aviation Authority recognizes that race-neutral measures alone are not sufficient to meet the overall goal; therefore, it will use the following measures to meet its overall goal:

- Establish concession-specific goals for concession when necessary;
- Negotiate with potential concessionaires to include ACDBE participation through direct ownership arrangements in the operation of a proposed concession; and
- Consideration will be provided to the extent of the competitor's ability to provide ACDBE participation when awarding a concession.



# ACDBE PARTICIPATION EXAMPLES

- ACDBE participation in a prime concession that an ACDBE obtains through customary competitive procurement procedures;
- ACDBE participation as a sub-concessionaire on a prime concession that does not carry an ACDBE goal;
- ACDBE participation on a prime concession exceeding a concession-specific goal, and
- ACDBE participation through a sub-concession from a prime concessionaire that does not consider the firm's ACDBE status in making the award.



### **MARKET AREA**

Based upon a list of car rental concessionaires and the limited opportunities available, the market area for car rental concessions was determined to be the State of Florida.



### STEP 1: BASE FIGURE Relative Availability of ACDBEs

The base figure for the relative availability of ACDBEs for car rental goods and services purchases was calculated as follows:

#### **Availability**

Ready, willing, and able car rental ACDBEs in the market area

All ready, willing and able car rental concession firms in the market area

When we calculated the average availability we arrived at the Step 1 base figure for the overall goal for car rental concessions of 3.8%.

### RACE-NEUTRAL PARTICIPATION BREAKDOWN

The Aviation Authority estimates that, in meeting the overall goal of 8%, it will obtain 0% from race-neutral participation and 8% through race-conscious measures.

The historical information on ACDBE participation on car rental concessions showed that there was not any race-neutral participation in the previous five-year period. **Overall Car Rental Concessions Goal: 8%**
