**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A." Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.

2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the **NOT TO EXCEED amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$107,792.00),** broken down as follows:

Re: Request for Recommendation of Approval of an Amendment to Addendum No. 9 to the Program and Project Management Services for the South Terminal C, Phase 1, Agreement with Geotech Consultants International, Inc. to provide Additional Construction Phase OAR Services for W-S111, Terminal C (Phase 1) – Program & Project Management Services at Orlando International Airport – FINAL SETTLEMENT

In October 2015, the Aviation Authority awarded five contracts for Program and Project Management Services for the South Terminal C, Phase 1 (a/k/a Terminal C OAR contracts) to the following firms:

- Geotechnical Consultants International, Inc. (GCI)
- Cost Management, Inc. (CMI)
- Page One Consultants, Inc., n/k/a NV5
- KMI International Inc. (KMI) final payment made
- CMTS Construction Management Services, LLC (CMTS) final payment made

#### Background for this Addendum

The scope of services for this Addendum included construction phase OAR services for FY22. On November 23, 2021, the Construction Committee recommended approval of Addendum 9 in the amount of \$4,735,745.00 which the Aviation Authority Board approved on December 15, 2021.On May 3, 2022, the Construction Committee recommended approval of Amendment 1 to the Addendum for \$1,310,440.00 which the Aviation Authority Board approved on May 18, 2022. On June 7, 2022, the Construction Committee approved Amendment 2 to the Addendum for \$3,299,440.00 which the Aviation Authority Board approved on July 20, 2022. On June 28, 2022, the Construction Committee approved Amendment 3 to extend the completion date to July 31, 2022. On August 30, 2022, the Construction Committee approved Amendment 4 in the amount of \$0.00. On August 30, 2022, the Construction Committee recommended approval of Amendment 5 to the Addendum for \$453,469.00 which the Aviation Authority Board approved on September 21, 2022. On November 22, 2022 the Construction Committee recommended approval of Amendment 6 to the Addendum for \$641,296.00 which the Aviation Authority Board approved Amendment 7 to the Addendum for \$38,304.00.

### ssues

On September 20, 2022, Terminal C opened to passenger traffic. Final payment has been made on two of the Terminal C OAR contracts (KMI and CMTS) with no issues, as those contracts were more limited in scope and did not have any subconsultants.

For the remaining three Terminal C OAR contracts, a global final settlement has been negotiated to resolve all requests for cost, time, and any other issues that were or could have been raised in connection of the W-S111 OAR contracts and the performance of OAR project management services for Terminal C.

The proposed settlement includes the following amendments, which result in a net credit to the Aviation Authority:

The remaining three OAR firms and their subconsultants have agreed to submit a final invoice for each addendum of their W-S111 contracts no later than October 30, 2023. To enable the submission and payment of a final invoice in accordance with this agreement, additional funding of \$107,832.00 is required. The final invoice for Addendum 09 will not exceed the remaining balance on this Addendum. The OAR firms and their subconsultants have accepted final payment on all other addenda/amendments that are not included in the above table and have agreed that no additional invoices will be submitted.

The Aviation Authority acknowledges that the services have been satisfactory performed and it has received the benefit of the services, which were instrumental in the successful completion of the construction services and opening of Terminal C. Since that time, lessons learned and best practices regarding capital program management have been incorporated into the Authority's capital program. Specifically, an executive program management firm has been retained for the follow-on expansion of Terminal C projects to avoid having a patchwork of multiple project management contracts with multiple addenda and amendments spanning different time periods.

The 2022 continuing program and project management services contracts are <u>not</u> impacted by this settlement.

The MWBE/LDB participation has been reviewed by the Office of Small Business Development. Their findings and recommendation are attached.

Funding is from General Airport Revenue Bonds, PFC, FDOT, and CFC. Funding source verified by <u>*Melvin Martinez*</u> of Construction Finance on  $\frac{09}{28}$  /  $\frac{23}{23}$  as correct and available.

It is respectfully requested that the Construction Committee approve an Amendment to Addendum No. 9 to the Program and Project Management Services Agreement with Geotech Consultants International, Inc. for the services contained herein and amount as shown below:
