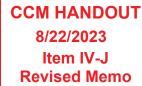

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

(rev 03/23/2022)

- 1. <u>General</u>. The following Terms and Conditions of Sale ("Terms and Conditions") shall govern all sales of goods or services ("Goods" or "Services") provided by ORR Protection Systems, Inc. ("ORR") to any buyer or enduser with whom ORR undertakes to deal (the "Customer"). - 2. Price. Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by ORR, the Price excludes all sales, use and other governmental charges and taxes relating to the production, shipment or purchase of Goods or Services hereunder, and shall be payable by Customer directly to the appropriate governmental agency. All Services shall be performed during regular business hours. In the event Customer requests performance at any other time, an additional amount shall be billed and paid by Customer, over and above the agreed upon contract Price, as compensation for overtime wages and for other expenses occasioned thereby.
- 3. Payment. Payment shall be due and payable thirty (30) days from invoice date. Past due accounts are subject to a late fee of one and one-half percent (1½%) per month or the highest rate permitted by law. Acceptance of payment on any past due amounts shall not be deemed a waiver of any rights ORR may have against Customer for late payment.
