ADDENDUM NO. 8 TO THE AGREEMENT DATED JUNE 10, 2021 BETWEEN GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY AND HNTB CORPORATION

THIS ADDENDUM is effective this _____ day of _____, 20_22_, by and between the GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY ("Authority"), and HNTB CORPORATION ("Consultant').

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Agreement dated June 10, 2021, Authority and Consultant entered into an agreement for Consultant to provide Continuing Transportation Planning Consulting Services; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, Consultant agreed to perform such additional services for the Authority as are contained in any additional scope of work established by the Authority in any addendum to the Agreement and accepted in writing by the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Addendum to the Agreement to provide for additional services to be rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A." Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.
- 2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the NOT TO EXCEED amount of FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$423,360.00), broken down as follows:

Reimbursable Expenses: NTE: \$0.00

Total: \$423,360.00

 A. Consultant hereby certifies that it is not on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List and is not engaged in a boycott of Israel, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended;

AND

- B. (applicable to agreements that may be \$1,000,000 or more) Consultant hereby certifies that it is: (1) not on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135; and (2) not engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended.
- 4. Authority may terminate the Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel.

In the event the Agreement is for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, Authority may terminate this Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

5. Except as expressly modified in this Addendum, the Agreement dated June 10, 2021 and all prior addenda will remain in full force and effect.



HNTB Corporation (HNTB) is pleased to submit this proposal for transportation consulting services associated with supporting Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) staff with Staff Extension Services for the fiscal year 2023. For purposes of this agreement, GOAA will be referred to as the Client and HNTB will be referred to as the Consultant.

SCOPE

In summary, the Authority's Planning & Development and Engineering & Construction Departments have requested HNTB Corporation to provide extension of staff services on transportation planning and related environmental and safety tasks, help manage projects and programs and the associated day-to-day tasks, participate in strategic planning for transportation and related environmental issues associated with the Authority's transportation projects and develop planning books/scopes for their consultants.

Specifically, the services will consist of acting as an extension of the Authority's staff to focus on transportation and related environmental support including:

- Interfacing with transportation and regulatory compliance agencies (FDOT, CFX, FAA, FDEP, USACOE, SFWMD, SJRWMD, etc.) on issues such as FAA Compliance, NPDES, SPCC, NEPA, EA/EIS.
- Ongoing routine transportation projects' environmental tasks including but not limited to compliance monitoring, permit completion and permit requirements implementation.
- Monitoring transportation projects' construction activities for proper execution of regulatory compliance and environmental permit requirements as planned.
- Coordinating with the Authority's network of planning, engineering and environmental consultants.
- Coordinating with the Authority's general consultant on transportation and related environmental aspects of projects.
- Coordinating with Authority staff to identify cost savings initiatives regarding transportation projects and associated infrastructure and utilities.
- As directed by Authority staff, fostering relationships with outside governmental transportation and regulatory agencies and explore potential partnerships between they Authority and outside

private entities related to mutually beneficial transportation and related environmental and utility opportunities.

- Providing support to Authority staff for project oversight including, but not limited to, project management, inspection and inspection coordination, strategic planning, engineering review, tenant interaction.
- As may be directed by Authority management staff, representing the Authority with outside consultants, contractors or vendors on transportation, environmental and planning subjects.

SCHEDULE

Based on the Authority's request, these services are proposed beginning on October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, at 100% (full) time, with reduction for holidays and vacation time, for a total of 245 "workdays" (1,960 hours).

FEE

HNTB proposes to provide a project director to staff this position on a not to exceed basis for this period, as shown in HNTB Professional Fee Breakdown, for the proposed not to exceed labor fee of \$423,360.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation of the Construction Committee to Approve an Addendum to the Continuing Transportation Planning Services Agreement with HNTB Corporation, for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Staff Extension Services for Transportation Planning and Related Tasks

BACKGROUND

In 2021, the firms providing Continuing Transportation Planning Services were selected through a competitive award process. These services are procured on an as-needed or annual basis.

On May 19, 2021, the Aviation Authority Board approved a Continuing Transportation Planning Services Agreement with the following firms:

- HDR Engineering, Inc.
- HNTB Corporation

These no-cost base agreements established the negotiated hourly rates. These services consist of the performance of transportation planning services and related professional services, and may include, but not be limited to, on-airport roadway traffic counts, multi-modal transportation facility planning, airport passenger surface access-related analyses, coordination with local, regional, state and federal transportation agencies on transportation planning issues to support the development of the Aviation Authority's existing and future facilities; assisting with strategic development planning, planning analyses of roadway opportunities and constraints, wayfinding and signage, and other miscellaneous transportation projects and all other related services including coordination with the Aviation Authority, its Consultants, the City of Orlando and all agencies having jurisdiction over the facilities. The Services may also include, but are not limited to, studies and preparation of reports involving scope definition and validation of projects, evaluation and documentation of existing conditions; Master Document support, plan review and support of the Aviation Authority's horizontal permitting program, technical support and review of documents prepared by others, management support on various Aviation Authority projects and all other related professional services.

ISSUES

A fee has been negotiated with HNTB Corporation for a total amount of \$423,360 for FY 2023 Staff Extension Services for Transportation Planning and Related Tasks. These services provide for extension of staff support services for transportation planning and related environmental and safety tasks, and include, but are not limited to, assistance in the management of projects and programs and the associated day-to-day tasks, participation in strategic planning for transportation and related environmental issues associated with the Aviation Authority's transportation projects, and development of

planning books/scopes. Services will be provided from October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023. At the discretion of the Aviation Authority, the level of provided services may be adjusted during the fiscal year, depending on fluctuations of Aviation Authority staffing levels.

The Aviation Authority has reviewed the proposal from HNTB Corporation and determined that HNTB Corporation does not propose any small business participation on this addendum as the services to be provided are for onsite staffing support, and certifies that HNTB Corporation is in good standing as it relates to its small business participation.

On August 23, 2022, the Construction Committee recommended approval of an Addendum to the Continuing Transportation Planning Services Agreement with HNTB Corporation for FY 2023 Staff Extension Services for Transportation Planning and Related Tasks, as outlined in the memorandum.

ALTERNATIVES

None.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact is \$423,360. Funding is from Operation and Maintenance Funds (subject to adoption of the FY 2023 Aviation Authority Budget by the Aviation Authority Board under separate item).

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board resolve to accept the recommendation of the Construction Committee and approve an Addendum to the Continuing Transportation Planning Services Agreement with HNTB Corporation, for FY 2023 Staff Extension Services for Transportation Planning and Related Tasks, for a total not-to-exceed fee amount of \$423,360, with funding from Operation and Maintenance Funds; and authorize an Aviation Authority Officer or the Chief Executive Officer to execute the necessary documents following satisfactory review by legal counsel.
