WHEREAS, under the Agreement, Consultant agreed to perform such additional services for the Aviation Authority as are contained in any additional scope of work established by the Aviation Authority in any addendum to the Agreement and accepted in writing by the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Addendum to the Agreement to provide for additional services to be rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A." Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.
- 2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the **NOT TO EXCEED amount of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$189,005.00)**, broken down as follows:

In the event the Agreement is for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, Aviation Authority may terminate this Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

5. Except as expressly modified in this Addendum, the Agreement dated March 31, 2023 and all prior addenda will remain in full force and effect.

ATTACHMENT A: SCOPE OF SERVICES ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT J-HOOK POND DESIGN AND STORMATER ANALYSIS GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY

OVERVIEW

The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) is planning for future land use activities. GOAA is currently planning for taxiway and Terminal C expansion and associated infrastructure. This project consists of the drainage design and grading of the area south of Terminal C and north of the Brightline railway, which is currently planned as the main drainage path to convey stormwater runoff from Phase 1 and Phase II of the Terminal C development program.

The services provided by Kimley-Horn and Associates will consist of the design of stormwater management systems to serve the future development, preparation of construction documents, and the development of a Rough Order of Magnitude (ROM) to construct the proposed improvements.

SCOPE:

This project includes the design of a new stormwater management and conveyance pond known as the "J-Hook" pond to accommodate for the future development of Phase 2 of Terminal C as well as improve stormwater conveyance south, under the Brightline railway, to the C2 control structure, stormwater analysis and modeling of the new pond, and development of a Rough Order of Magnitude (ROM) to construct the proposed improvements. Orange County LiDAR and topographic survey will be used for determining the topography of the site.

As with any project such as this, it is necessary to ensure all stormwater runoff drains appropriately to a stormwater management system that has capacity to provide water quality and attenuation prior to discharging to a permitted outfall location to avoid any adverse impacts. The planned project area will construct a new stormwater management system where there is currently only a small ditch. The intent is to design a stormwater management facility that can be utilized for the future development and will ultimately need to be constructed in order to serve the site. Specifically, this project includes:

- 1. Development of Construction Documents.
- Design of stormwater management facilities to accommodate for future Terminal C expansion.
- Development of an Opinion of Probable Construction Costs (OPC) to construct the stormwater management facility and convey the stormwater downstream, under the Brightline rail corridor.
- 4. Assist GOAA with the bid and award of the project.

The project is expected to require professional civil design services. The basic scope of services for this project includes the following Tasks:

- Task 1 Data Collection and Preliminary Design
- Task 2 Construction Documents Preparation
- Task 3 Bid and Award Services

TASK ONE – Data Collection and Preliminary Design

The purpose of this Task is to collect the data needed to prepare the Construction Documents for the proposed project. The data collection and preliminary design effort will involve:

- (1) Attend one (1) design kick-off and scope verification meeting with relevant stakeholders. Provide meeting minutes of that meeting.
- (2) Review relevant existing record drawings, plans, existing airport base mapping and airport layout plan (ALP).
- (3) Define and list design criteria applicable to the project.
- (4) Complete field review of the site.
- (5) A topographic survey will be performed by L&S Diversified, LLC.
- (6) Develop preliminary development planning documents and discuss the development plan with GOAA for review and comments.
- (7) Attend one (1) review meeting with GOAA.
- (8) Provide administration for the services including progress reports, record keeping, coordination, and invoicing.

The data collection and preliminary design effort will begin with a "site review" to evaluate and document existing site conditions of the area included within the project limits. A set of preliminary planning documents will be prepared from the information developed during the "site review". The preliminary design is intended to convey our understanding and findings of the existing topography, utilities, and drainage within the project limits to GOAA and will include only minimal design level notations. Kimley-Horn will meet with GOAA to discuss the preliminary design documents and incorporate input from this meeting into the schematic design documents.

Deliverables:

- (1) 1 copy of the Preliminary Planning Design Documents
- (2) 1 copy of the topographic survey prepared by L&S Diversified, LLC in AutoCAD format.

TASK TWO – Construction Documents Preparation

The purpose of this Task is to prepare Construction Documents (CDs) that can be used by GOAA to solicit bids from qualified Contractors for the purpose of conducting the work proposed under this Program. Specifically, under this Task, CDs will be prepared for the construction of the stormwater management facility (J-Hook Pond). For the purposes of this project, Construction

Documents include Plans and Technical Specifications. Under this Task, 95% complete CDs will be prepared for review and approval by GOAA. All review comments generated by GOAA during review of the Preliminary Design Plans will be incorporate in the 95% CD's. The 100% CDs will incorporate comments generated from the 95% CD submittal and will then be submitted to GOAA for final approval. Both the 95% and 100% CD submittals will include an Opinion of Probable Construction Costs for the proposed project.

Deliverables:

- (1) 1 copy of the 95% Construction Documents (electronic copy)
- (2) 1 copy of the 100% Construction Documents (electronic copy)

TASK THREE – Bidding and Award Services

After acceptance by GOAA of the Bidding Documents (100% Plans and Technical Specifications) the design phase will be complete. The Engineer will then assist GOAA in the bid and award of the project. The Engineer will assist the Owner in advertising for and obtaining bids for the proposed project; maintain a record of prospective bidders to whom Bid Documents have been issued; attend the Pre-Bid Conference; and reproduce and distribute Bid Documents and Addenda to the Owner, plan rooms and prospective Bidders. Specifically, this Task involves:

- (1) Assist GOAA in preparing for bid of the project.
- (2) Attend a pre-bid meeting for prospective bidders and prepare meeting minutes.
- (3) Provide responses to questions raised by potential bidders during advertisement and review time.
- (4) Prepare addenda during the advertisement.
- (5) Review bids submitted and assist GOAA in evaluating bids.
- (6) Prepare bid tabulation.
- (7) Prepare a recommendation for award of bid.

The Bidding and Award Services will be considered complete upon commencement of Construction or upon cessation of negotiations with prospective Contractors.

Deliverables:

(1) 1 electronic copy of the 100% Bid Documents (Plans and Specifications)
