ITEM DESCRIPTION

Request of Approval of Amendment 2 to Addendum No. 8 to the Continuing Environmental Consulting Services Agreement with MSE Group, LLC. for Additional FY 2024 Wildlife Hazard Assessment Survey and Report at the Orlando International Airport.

BACKGROUND

In 2021, the firms providing Continuing Environmental Consulting Services were selected through a competitive award process. These services are procured on an as-needed or annual basis.

On April 21, 2021, the Aviation Authority Board approved a Continuing Environmental Consulting Services Agreement with the following firms:

- Breedlove, Dennis and Associates, Inc.
- Bio-Tech Consulting, Inc.
- DRMP, Inc.
- The Transit Group, Inc. d/b/a Ecological Associates, Inc.
- EXP U.S. Service, Inc.
- MSE Group, LLC
- Terracon Consultants, Inc.
- Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc.

On September 27, 2023, the Aviation Authority Board approved Addendum No. 8 to the Continuing Environmental Consulting Services Agreement with MSE Group, LLC for FY 2024 Wildlife Hazard Assessment Survey and Report at the Orlando International Airport, for the total amount of \$82,232.00. Since that time is has been determined that additional scope and funding is needed to conduct roosting and nesting bird surveys at OIA.

These no-cost base agreements established the negotiated hourly rates. The continuing environmental consulting services may include, but are not limited to, evaluation and assessment of wildlife issues, uplands and wetlands evaluation, habitat analysis, threatened and endangered species issues, jurisdictional wetland determinations, water quality analysis, land management, and monitoring of wetlands mitigation on facilities operated or purchased by the Aviation Authority and all other related services including coordination with the Aviation Authority, its Consultants, the City of Orlando and all agencies having jurisdiction over the facilities. The Services may also include preparation of required notices and reports, coordination and providing assistance with requirements of authorities having jurisdiction over various mitigation sites, documentation of existing environmental conditions, preparation of environmental studies, technical support, and assistance with permitting activities which may be required where the Aviation Authority elects not to solicit letters of interest by means of public advertisement.

ISSUES

Consultant's proposal, dated April 16, 2024, is to provide weekly nesting bird and egg surveys.

Upon completion of all required documentation, services will be effective no earlier than Procurement Committee approval.

The cumulative contract value of all addenda/amendments since the last approval by the Aviation Authority Board for the Continuing Environmental Consulting Services Agreement with MSE Group, LLC, is below the \$250,000 threshold; thus, this agenda item does not require Board approval.

SMALL BUSINESS

The MWBE/LDB/VBE participation has been reviewed by the Office of Small Business Development. The findings and recommendation are attached.

ALTERNATIVES

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact is \$33,653.00. Funding is from previously-approved Operation and Maintenance Funds.



- Establish and maintain access to bird nesting areas upon the islands.
- Addle eggs of nuisance and nesting birds on the islands within SW-04.
 - This will be conducted In general accordance of the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS) Wildlife Neighbors Canada Goose Egg Addling Protocol (January 2002) and consistent with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission abatement permit for GOAA.
- Data collected during NBES operations will be entered into Microsoft Excel spreadsheets and all data QC'd.





- We will notify GOAA of any nesting protected species identified during surveys.
- We will incorporate the NBES results in the annual Wildlife Hazard Assessment Report.

Schedule

Upon your authorization, MSE will coordinate with the appropriate GOAA personnel to develop a project schedule that meets the time frames anticipated for the project.

Cost Proposal

The scope of services defined above will be completed on a **time and materials basis not to exceed \$33,653.00.** MSE will utilize the unit rates provided in **Attachment A**.
