WHEREAS, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Addendum to the Agreement to provide for additional services to be rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A." Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.
- 2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the **NOT TO EXCEED amount of THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$31,654.00)**, broken down as follows:

- A. Consultant hereby certifies that it is not on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List and is not engaged in a boycott of Israel, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended; AND
 - B. (applicable to agreements that may be \$1,000,000 or more) Consultant hereby certifies that it is: (1) not on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy

Sector List as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135; and (2) not engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended.

4. Aviation Authority may terminate the Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel.

In the event the Agreement is for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, Aviation Authority may terminate this Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

5. Except as expressly modified in this Addendum, the Agreement dated January 8, 2021 and all prior addenda will remain in full force and effect.

On-Call Services to be completed by Spencer Consulting Services (SCS) will encompass:

SCOPE OF WORK:

Backup Electric Generation:

The new South Terminal Complex (STC) includes 24 megawatts of backup generation. GOAA has executed and agreement with OUC to own and operate the STC backup electric generation facilities.

SCS is positioned to assist GOAA to with ongoing OUC issues with the OUC's operation of this facility:

- 1. Assist with the review of monthly OUC billing
- 2. Assist with the administration of the OUC EPG Agreements
- 3. Attend meetings as required

Chilled Water

The new South Terminal includes 10,000 tons of chilled water capacity. GOAA has executed an agreement with OUC to own and operate the STC Central Energy Plant (CEP) facility:

SCS is positioned to assist GOAA to with ongoing OUC issues with the OUC's operation of this facility:

- 1. Assist with the review of monthly OUC billing
- 2. Assist with the administration of the OUC CEP Agreements
- 3. Attend Meetings as required

Water, Waste Water and Electric Connection Fees:

SCS provides extensive services to estimate water, waste water, and electric connection fees. The goal of SCS is to work with the engineers of each project to develop consumption data that is consistent with actual usage rather than typical design methodologies.

GOAA has a standard agreement that OUC connection fees (SDC) are calculated based on the flows of month 13 to 24 after initial operation. SCS, monitors these flows and works with OUC to determine the flows for the fee calculation. Waste water flows are calculated by standards issued by the City of Orlando. SCS applies the same logic to determine a more appropriate flow. If the flow is less than the flow produced by the City standards, GOAA can apply to the City to pay a certain agreed to fee and have the fee reviewed at a later date. After the review, there is a true up of the fee.

Electric connection fees are established by OUC and are based on the kilovolt-ampere (kVa) of transformers and a percentage of the onsite costs. SCS works with the electrical designer to minimize these fees.

OUC Billing:

SCS provides knowledge to assist GOAA in avoiding financial losses on the OUC bill. SCS reviews for appropriate rate structures and other services such as credit meters on cooling towers. GOAA and OUC have agreed to allow GOAA to not pay certain water fees at the time of the water meter sets. Payment will be made two years after operation. This will require an escrow of appropriate funds. These calculations will be critical to appropriate funds for future payments. SCS will work with OUC to have the calculated water consumption to be a net add of all GOAA facilities.

OUC Interfaces:

Every significant project has many utility options available. SCS works with the owner to establish issues that will need to be addressed with OUC. SCS has the contacts within OUC to move these issues through the process quickly and efficiently involving only the correct players in the process.

Miscellaneous Utility Issues:

SCS provides a wide assortment of knowledge on utility issues as they may occur. These can be project related or operational. These are typically in the following areas.

- 1. Assist the owner with requests by OUC or City of Orlando Waste Water
- 2. Coordinate OUC on-site activities

Summary of Proposed Not To Exceed Professional Fees:


