



## **TERMINAL C TECHNOLOGY FEATURES**

- **100% facial recognition** for international arrival and departures
- TSA security screening lanes featuring an automated bin return system
- A new "Bags First" method for arriving international travelers. Passengers retrieve their "Bags First" then proceed to U.S. Customs and Immigration
- Radio Frequency Identification Technology (RFID) Tote Baggage Handling System for efficient tracking

- Simultaneous international and domestic gate arrival operations
- Adjacent to MCO's train station with highspeed inter-city rail service commencing in 2023
- With sustainability in mind, many design elements for the Terminal C target LEED®v4 certification, including areas such as energy efficiency, indoor air quality and resiliency
