

**ADDENDUM NO. 2
TO THE AGREEMENT DATED JANUARY 9, 2024
BETWEEN GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY
AND TERRACON CONSULTANTS, INC.**

**Project: FY25 Semi-Annual Groundwater Monitoring and Reporting for PR-005
Cargo Road Landfill, Orlando International Airport**

THIS ADDENDUM is effective this 3rd day of September, 2024, by and between the **GREATER ORLANDO AVIATION AUTHORITY** (“Aviation Authority”), and **TERRACON CONSULTANTS, INC.** (“Consultant”).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Agreement dated January 9, 2024, Aviation Authority and Consultant entered into an agreement for Consultant to provide continuing environmental engineering consulting services; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, Consultant agreed to perform such additional services for the Aviation Authority as are contained in any additional scope of work established by the Aviation Authority in any addendum to the Agreement and accepted in writing by the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant desire to enter into this Addendum to the Agreement to provide for additional services to be rendered by the Consultant under the terms of said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Aviation Authority and the Consultant do hereby agree as follows:

1. Consultant shall perform additional services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the attached Exhibit “A.” Consultant shall be paid for such additional services according to the payment terms set forth in the Agreement.
2. Consultant shall be compensated for such additional services in the **NOT TO EXCEED amount of THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$36,982.00)**, broken down as follows:

3. A. Consultant hereby certifies that it is not on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List and is not engaged in a boycott of Israel, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended;

AND

B. (applicable to agreements that may be \$1,000,000 or more) - Consultant hereby certifies that it is: (1) not on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135; and (2) not engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria, as defined in Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended.


4. Authority may terminate the Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel.

In the event the Agreement is for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, Authority may terminate this Agreement for cause and without the opportunity to cure if the Consultant is found to have submitted a false certification or has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.


5. Except as expressly modified in this Addendum, the Agreement dated January 9, 2024 and all prior addenda will remain in full force and effect.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Request for Approval of an Addendum to the Continuing Environmental Engineering Consulting Services Agreement with Terracon Consultants, Inc. for FY25 Semi-annual Groundwater Monitoring and Reporting for PR-005 Cargo Road Landfill (Site) at Orlando International Airport.

BACKGROUND

On December 13, 2023, the Aviation Authority Board approved an agreement with Terracon Consultants, Inc. for Continuing Environmental Engineering Consulting Services at the Orlando International Airport, Orlando Executive Airport, and other facilities operated by the Aviation Authority. These services include environmental consulting services; conducting all phases of environmental contamination assessments for petroleum and hazardous materials; storage tank management; emergency response to fuel, petroleum, and hazardous material incidents, including immediate response to limit releases to the environment, performance of initial remedial actions and other related services.

ISSUES

Consultant's proposal, dated August 15, 2024, is to provide Semiannual Groundwater Monitoring and Reporting for the Cargo Road Landfill (Site) for October 2024 and April 2025. These activities are required for the site by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), pursuant to the Monitoring Plan Implementation Schedule dated January 31, 2006.

If approved, services will be effective the date of Construction Committee approval.

As per your request, the following is Terracon's scope of services and associated costs to conduct semi-annual groundwater sampling, analyses and reporting activities for the Cargo Road Landfill (Site) for October 2024 and April 2025. These activities are required for the site by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), pursuant to the Monitoring Plan Implementation Schedule dated January 31, 2006. This proposal outlines our understanding of the project and presents the costs to perform semi-annual groundwater monitoring through April 2025, as directed in the August 13, 2024 FDEP correspondence.

A. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Terracon has a personal and uncompromising commitment to everyone going home safely each and every day. Our safety program, *Incident and Injury Free*® is about care and concern for people. It is our personal and organizational commitment at all levels of the company and is where safety is held as a core value as well as an operational priority. Working safely is an inseparable part of working correctly, just as much as other operational priorities, in particular quality, profitability and schedule. As part of our IIF process, in addition to a Site Health and Safety Plan (HASP) we will prepare a "Pre-Task Plan" to identify the potential site safety and job hazards associated with the work proposed at this site. Prior to commencement and during the on-site activities, we will re-evaluate potential job hazards and appropriate safe working procedures. At this time, we anticipate performing fieldwork in a USEPA Level D work uniform consisting of hard hats, safety glasses, protective gloves, and steel-toed boots. It may become necessary to upgrade this level of protection, at additional cost, while sampling activities are being conducted in the event that petroleum or chemical constituents are encountered in groundwater that present an increased risk for personal exposure.

Terracon will perform the semi-annual sampling activities that will generally consist of the following:

1. As directed by the FDEP, implement the sampling and monitoring activities pursuant to the above referenced documents in 29 existing groundwater monitoring wells forming the network of perimeter sampling points for the referenced closed landfill. Shallow monitoring wells include: SWQ-3, SWQ-4, SWQ-6 through SWQ-10, SWQ-12, SWQ-13, SWQ-23, SWQ-24, and deep monitoring wells DWQ-3, DWQ-4, DWQ-6 through DWQ-10, DWQ-12, DWQ-16 through DWQ-20, and DWQ-22 through DWQ-26.
2. Measurements of the depth to groundwater, groundwater elevations and repair or replacement of monitoring well casings, well caps, manhole covers, and concrete pads as needed.
3. Collection of groundwater samples from the 29 monitoring wells. Field parameters for temperature, dissolved oxygen, pH, specific conductance and turbidity will be recorded for each monitoring well during purging prior to sample collection. The samples will be submitted to the laboratory testing facility for analyses of the following constituents: volatile organic compounds (VOCs) by United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) analytical method 8260, polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) by EPA Method 8270 SIM, chloride by EPA Method 300.0, ammonia by EPA Method 350.1, and iron and thallium by EPA Method 6020 as presented on the following table.

4. Quality control: Collect at least one (1) trip blank per sample cooler for the VOCs parameters during each sampling event.
5. Preparation of a semi-annual monitoring report for each of the two events for submittal to the FDEP’s Central District Office within 30 days of receipt of the laboratory analytical reports. The reports will summarize the sampling methodology, the field and analytical results and our conclusions and recommendations.

All field sampling activities will be performed by Terracon in general accordance with the FDEP’s guidance document Standard Operating Procedures for Field Activities, DEP-SOP-001/01, effective April 16, 2018. Laboratory analyses will be performed by a State of Florida certified environmental testing laboratory, in general accordance with their National Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program approved Quality Assurance Plan, certified by the Florida Department of Health. As before, Terracon will utilize a subcontract minority owned laboratory testing business enterprise, Southern Research Laboratories (SRL). The costs for any additional sampling events not specified herein, if needed and requested by the FDEP, will be provided under a separate proposal for GOAA’s review and authorization.

B. COMPENSATION

Terracon is prepared to implement the above generally outlined scope of services immediately upon your notice to proceed. Our estimated cost to complete the project is a not to exceed amount of **\$36,982.00**, consisting of \$17,950.00 in Reimbursable Expenses and \$19,032.00 in Professional Service Fees. A breakdown of these costs including a summary of the DBE participation may be found on **Attachments A** and **B**, respectively. A copy of the SRL fee schedule is provided in **Attachment C**. The Truth in Negotiation Certification is provided in **Attachment D**.
