

Dear Mr. Friel:

VHB has been assisting the Authority with the Mud Lake conservation easement release activities through the addendum referenced above which was executed on May 31, 2022, and an amendment authorized on November 7, 2023. The scope of work included an evaluation of the proposed release area and its associated mitigation credits. The scope also includes the development of the release justification and preliminary meetings with the regulatory agencies (South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) and a US Army Corps of Engineers (Corps).

The preliminary tasks associated with the addendum have been completed and additional work to draft and submit the permit application packages to the regulatory agencies has also occurred. As a result of permitting agency meetings and permit application submission, the SFWMD has requested additional meetings and analyses in order to process the application. VHB estimates that this effort will require approximately \$85,144 in fees for VHB and \$25,200 in subconsultant fees for DeLisi, Inc. The approximate breakdown of these fees is outlined in the attached Exhibit B.

At the time of the addendum, it was known that an amendment to prepare and process the permit modification application would be provided following the initial agency meetings. As such, we respectfully request a contract amendment for a budget increase to our addendum/(PO No. 94768) in the amount of \$110,344 to cover this effort.
